Adam Ferrett, 32, son of Rick and Sharon Ferrett grew up in St. Joseph. He attended Prairieview School and St. Joseph Ogden High School where he participated in many activities including: Cub Scouts, 4-H, sports, and band. He also grew up in the St. Joseph United Methodist Church and was actively involved in church activities, youth programs, and mission experiences. He served in the United States Navy for four years and most recently returned to live in this area after the unexpected death of his father in 2009. He was working at Carle Foundation Hospital as power plant operator and was passionate about playing golf in his spare time, when he was involved in a catastrophic car accident on April 22, 2011 and sustained a serious spinal cord injury which left him a quadriplegic. Although he is in good spirits, he has a long and difficult road ahead. Currently he is at the Rehabilitation Institute of Chicago (RIC) and we are all hopeful that through their aggressive rehab and therapy program he may regain some of what he has lost and learn how to function most effectively with those abilities. Throughout this long process Adam anxiously looks forward to coming home.
